Directions

1 lb. = 3 Cups

We recommend wearing gardening gloves when feeding your plants

New Plantings

Plant bulbs in loose, well drained soil rich in organic matter.

Plant bulbs at the correct depth recommended by the grower.

Individual Bulbs:

Place 1½ heaping teaspoons of Bulb-tone[®] into the planting hole and cover with soil.

Row Planting:

Mix 1½ lbs. (4.5 cups) of Bulb-tone into the soil for each 25 feet of row.

Bed Plantings:

Apply 4 lbs. per 60 square feet of bed area; mix to a depth at or below the bulb planting depth.

Established Plants

When to Feed:

Spring & Summer Plantings - Feed when plants reach 6 inches in height.

Dahlias and Gladioli can be fed monthly.

Fall Plantings - Feed after Spring bloom

How to Apply:

Individual Bulbs:

Apply 1½ heaping teaspoons around each plant; keep 2 to 3 inches away from bulb stem.

Bed Plantings:

Apply 4 lbs. per 60 square feet of bed area and wash off any plant food that is on the foliage.

Approximate Bulb Depths:

2 to 3 times diameter

3 to 4 times diameter of small bulbs

Approximate Distance Apart:

Large Bulbs: 1½ to 2 times planting depth

Small Bulbs: 2 to 3 times planting depth
