Directions

1 lb. = 3 Cups

We recommend wearing gardening gloves when feeding your plants.

New Plantings

Garden Beds: Mix 3 lbs. (9 cups) of Garden-tone per 50 square feet into the top 4-6 inches of soil along with compost, peat moss or Espoma Organic Garden Soil.

Individual Plants: Mix 3 tbsp. of Garden-tone into the soil when planting.

Established Plants

When to Feed: Feed seedlings & transplants with Garden-tone 10 days after planting and continue feeding monthly during the growing season (usually May through August).

How to Apply:

Single Plants - Sprinkle 1/3 cup around the drip line of the plant.

Row Plantings - Sprinkle 1 1/3 cup each side per 5 feet of row or 10 lbs. per 100 feet of row.

Keep plant food 3 inches from stem. Water thoroughly after feeding.

Potted Plants

New Plants:

When preparing soil for new plants, mix 2 cups of Garden-tone per cubic foot of soil (1.5 tbsp. per quart).

Established Plants:

Sprinkle 1.5 tsp. of Garden-tone for every 4 inches of pot diameter into the soil along the outer edge of the pot. Water thoroughly.

When to Feed: Herbs in the garden will only need fertilizer at time of planting or after a large harvest.

How to Apply:

Single Plants - Sprinkle 1 tbsp. evenly under and around each plant.

Potted Plants - Use half rate for potted plants above.
